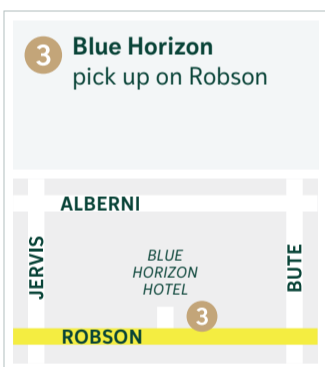
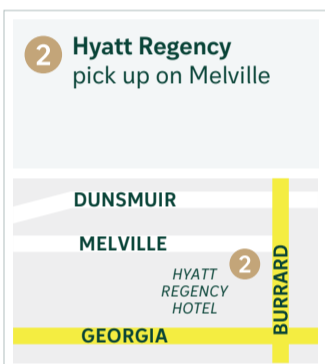

Why Capilano Suspension Bridge Park?

Do I need to pre-purchase tickets?

- Please book online to reserve an entrance time – capbridge.com
- Free shuttle reservations not required. First come, first served
- Proof of ticket purchase required to ride shuttle each way

COVID-19 precautions

- Timed ticketing in half hour increments in effect
- Face masks are encouraged but not required on both the free shuttle and in the park
- Hand sanitiser stations are located throughout the park
- Please do not enter the park if you are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19.
